***Conference Sessions***

- Session at the European Geosciences Union (EGU) General Assembly, Vienna, Austria, 17 - 22 April 2016: As in the previous years, a scientific conference session on *Sedimentary source-to-sink fluxes and sediment budgets*, convened by A.A. Beylich, D. Morche, K. Laute and A. Decaulne is proposed within the Geomorphology Programme of EGU 2016.
- Session at the 9<sup>th</sup> I.A.G. / A.I.G. International Conference on Geomorphology (9<sup>th</sup> ICG), New Delhi, India, 6 - 11 November 2017: As at the previous ICGs, a conference session on *Sediment budgets in cold environments (IAG-WG)* will be organized. The scientific session will be convened by A.A. Beylich and F. Lavigne.

***Publications***

- Status of the SEDIBUD Synthesis Book: The SEDIBUD Synthesis Book on *Source-to-sink fluxes in undisturbed cold environments*, edited by A.A.

Beylich, J.C. Dixon and Z. Zwolinski is now in production at Cambridge University Press (Cambridge, UK). Proofs will be sent to the book editors in due course. The book editors will forward the proofs to the corresponding book chapter authors for detailed checking.

- Special Issue arising from the SEDIBUD Workshop in 2014: A Special Issue to the journal Geomorphology (Morche, D., Krautblatter, M. and Beylich, A.A. (Eds.): *Sediment cascades in cold climate geosystems*) arising from the 8<sup>th</sup> SEDIBUD Workshop that took place at the Zugspitze in Germany in 2014 is currently in preparation. Manuscripts submitted to this Special Issue are currently under review.
- Report on the 9<sup>th</sup> SEDIBUD Workshop in 2015: A scientific report on the successful 9<sup>th</sup> SEDIBUD Workshop in 2015 will be prepared by the Workshop Organizers D. Morche and S. Kraushaar und will be submitted to the next I.A.G. / A.I.G. Newsletter.

- SEDIBUD Synthesis Paper: A *SEDIBUD Synthesis Paper*, integrating process geomorphologic work of SEDIBUD Members carried out at defined SEDIBUD Key Test Sites will be prepared over the coming 2 years by a selected group of SEDIBUD Members. The preparation of this synthesis paper will be led by A.A. Beylich and the manuscript shall be submitted to a leading international journal.

## **Meetings**

- SEDIBUD Workshops in 2016 and 2017: The 10<sup>th</sup> SEDIBUD Workshop will be organized by our Bulgarian colleagues (A. Baltakova et al.) in Bulgaria in September 2016. The field trip connected to this 10<sup>th</sup> SEDIBUD Workshop will take place in the area of Vihren peak (2914 m a.s.l.) in Pirin (and Banderitsa valley). A First Circular for this Workshop will be distributed in the beginning of December 2015.

The 11<sup>th</sup> and final SEDIBUD Workshop will be organized by our Romanian colleagues (O. Pop et al.) and will be held in a mountain chalet in the Fagaras Mts. (Balea Glacial Valley, Cabana Paltinu) located at about 2000 m a.s.l. in Romania in early September 2017. A First Circular for this Workshop will be distributed in early December 2016.
